

JUNIORS INTERESTED IN HOLDING AN OFFICE OR APPOINTMENT

THE FOLLOWING RULES ARE TO BE CONSIDERED WHEN SUBMITTING A JUNIOR NAME FOR THE VARIOUS POSITIONS

A girl elected as Honorary Department Junior President MUST be of Junior Membership eligibility (under age 18) at the time she presides at her Conference.

The Honorary Junior President and other officers will represent the Juniors at the National level according to the program arranged by National Officers.

A \$1000 scholarship called Burns "Reel Stars" will be awarded to the Honorary Junior Department President. She must have presided over the Junior Conference prior to acceptance. It will be awarded at Department Convention. It will be given to the recipient following confirmation of enrollment in college. The scholarship is made available to the Honorary Junior Department President by Past Department President Wanita Burns.

For speaking appointments, please choose a Junior who is able to read and speak distinctly and with volume.

Juniors appointed as Sergeant-at-Arms and Pages MUST wear a white top and black skirt or pants. No sandals. Gloves are not required. This also applies to Juniors carrying flags.

Please indicate on the registration form below the type of appointment each girl would like. THIS FORM MUST BE SUBMITTED TO DEPARTMENT CHAIRMAN STALTER BY MARCH 8, 2018.

Additional information regarding appointments will be sent directly to the Unit Junior Advisor after selections are made.

Necessary advance material, if needed, will also be sent at that time.

GUIDELINES FOR CHAMPAIGNING: Candidates for office may campaign during evening fun time. All campaigning must be done outside of the Conference Room. Please make campaigning fun for everyone. Use of posters, name tags, and flyers are allowed. DO NOT use gimmicks, favors, edibles, etc.
