## JUNIORS WANTING TO HOLD AN OFFICE

#### JUNIORS INTERESTED IN HOLDING AN OFFICE OR APPOINTMENT THE FOLLOWING RULES ARE TO BE CONSIDERED WHEN SUBMITTING A JUNIOR'S NAME FOR THE VARIOUS POSITIONS

1. A girl elected as Honorary Department Junior President MUST be of Junior Membership eligibility (under age 18) at the time she presides at her Conference. The Honorary Junior President and other officers will represent the Juniors at the National level according to the program arranged by National Officers.

2. For speaking appointments, please choose a Junior who is able to read and speak distinctly and with volume.

3. Juniors appointed as Sergeant-at-Arms and Pages MUST wear a white top and dark blue skirt or pants. No sandals. Gloves are not required. This also applies to Juniors carrying flags.

4. Please indicate on the registration form below the type of appointment each girl would like. THIS FORM MUST BE SUBMITTED TO DEPARTMENT CHAIRMAN Tina Abdelnour BY March 1, 2023 for Honorary Junior President or Vice President and March 10, 2023 for all other positions. Each location will have it's own appointments. Therefore, if appointed to position at Fairfield, that would be all she is required to do.

5. Additional information regarding appointments will be sent directly to the Unit Junior Advisor after selections are made. Necessary advance material, if needed, will also be sent at that time.

**GUIDELINES FOR CAMPAIGNING:** This year will be the same as last year. All Candidates for Honorary Junior Department President or Vice President will be **required** to make a campaign video that will be shown at all three locations just prior to elections. They will need to have someone to nominate them at the beginning of the video. That person will only state who is making the nomination and who they are nominating. The person who is nominated will then take over and have three minutes to make their campaign speech. I am encouraging them to make it as fun of a video as possible. Get as creative as you can. All video must be submitted to the Department Junior Activities Chairman Tina Abdelnour preferably by email at tabdelnour@illegion.org or on a SD Card or thumb drive via mail to: Tina Abdelnour, 209 S. # ALA ILLINI GIRLS STATE INFORMATION

Happy New Year ALA members! We are gearing up for a "BEARY" special week for ALA Illini Girls State Citizens and staff. The 82nd session of ALA Illini Girls State will be held on the campus of Eastern Illinois University in Charleston from Sunday June 18th to Saturday June 24th, 2023. During the week, citizens will learn about the voting process, elections, campaigning, patriotism and so much more. The ALA IGS Committee voted to leave the fee at \$250 for 2023. The application and program information were included in the fall packet.

Auxiliary members, we need your help! In the spirit of full transparency, ALA IGS is at a critical point that has the potential to either make or break this great program. Prior to Covid-19, we averaged between 330-450 participants at IGS. Between the virtual session in 2021 and the inperson 2022 session, we have only averaged between 120-170 participants. Not only do we need approximately 300 citizens to cover our staff and guest costs, but our participants are our strongest recruiters. They return to their schools and encourage their classmates to attend; having lower numbers is causing us to miss these connections to future participants. We must significantly increase our participants this year and need your help to do that. All Units are requested to send at least one girl to the 82nd session and to register citizens by May 1st for a chance to win a refund of your fee. If units are not able to send a citizen, we welcome donations to the program. Please continue to reach out to the committee if you have a delegate but no funds to sponsor them. We work to connect all interested girls with a sponsor and do not want to turn anyone away.

# As a reminder, we no longer offer transportation. Citizens will be responsible for transportation to and from EIU. Please encourage your citizens to carpool and consider giving them a gas card in the amount you would have spent for bus fare.

Please reach out to your schools **NOW**. This allows you to get girls before their summer plans fill up. Once you have selected delegates and are filling out the application, it is very important to fill out the entire application. This includes the middle section with the Unit and District information. If an application comes in without that information, it slows down the process and makes it difficult to assign cities.

The planning for the 82nd session of ALA Illini Girls State is underway. We look forward to being on the beautiful campus of Eastern Illinois University and meeting all the amazing future leaders from your communities! As always, the ALA IGS Committee continues to look for interested members to serve on our staff. If you are interested please contact Director Deb.
