CALL FOR REVISIONS TO DEPARTMENT CONSTITUTION, BYLAWS, AND

STANDING RULES, AND DISTRICT AND UNIT BYLAWS

In accordance with **ARTICLE VII – AMENDMENTS, Section 1,** of the Department Constitution and **ARTICLE X – AMENDMENTS** of Department Bylaws, call is hereby issued for such proposed revisions to reach Department Headquarters **NO LATER THAN APRIL 1, 2024.**

As stated in **ARTICLE VII** and **X**, all suggested amendments proposed will be sent to each Unit and District, as required, sixty days before the Department Convention, JULY 11, 12, 13, 2024. Final action will be taken at the Department Convention in Springfield, Illinois.

Each proposed revision must be submitted in triplicate. Each must also be sponsored by a Unit or signed by two members in good standing in the American Legion Auxiliary, Department of Illinois.

December 31: Six Point Program Donations need to be received at the Department office in order for a unit to receive the Unit citation for donating.

March 15: A donation in any amount to the Education Fund must be received for a unit to submit a candidate for an Education scholarship.

April 10: A donation in any amount to the Nurse's Scholarship <u>AND</u> Past President's Parley dues must be received for a unit to submit a candidate for the Nurse's scholarship.

May 31: Any donations received after May 31 will not appear in the Department Convention Book of Reports.

Many units send all their donations at once for the year using the snip sheet. Others spread their donations out over the year. It is the unit's choice when they want to donate.

American Legion Auxiliary Illini Girls State

Happy New Year ALA members! The ALA IGS Committee is working towards "Teaching real life superpowers to our future leaders through hands-on experiences--no capes needed!". The 83rd session of ALA Illini Girls State will be held on the campus of Eastern Illinois University in Charleston from Sunday June 16th to Saturday June 22nd, 2024. During the week, citizens will learn about the voting process, elections, campaigning, patriotism and so much more. The ALA IGS Committee voted to raise the fee to \$300 for 2024. The application and program information were included in the fall packet.

The ALA IGS committee is exploring direct contact methods with schools, in conjunction with the American Legion youth programs, to get the word directly out to schools about our programs. The ALA IGS committee has created a database of high schools across the state and the committee members will be recruiting to high schools. We still want Auxiliary members and units to reach out to schools, but be aware that the committee is working on increasing our attendance numbers as well. We know attendance as dropped and we need 300 citizens to cover our costs. I know with everyone working together we can see those numbers increase.

All units are requested to send at least one citizen to the 83rd session and register citizens as early as possible. The ALA IGS committee will be awarding two units who get applications in early. Unit raffle drawing for 1 unit to receive a registration refund if completed application and check arrive in the Department office by April 1st, 2024. Unit raffle drawing for 1 unit to receive registration refund if completed application and check arrive in the Department office by May 1st, 2024. Getting applications in early allows for the committee to plan for the session with appropriate numbers.

If units are not able to send a citizen, we welcome donations to the program. Please continue to reach out to the committee if you have a delegate but not funds to sponsor them. We work to connect all interested girls with a sponsor, and do not want to turn anyone away.

As a reminder, we no longer offer transportation. Citizens will be responsible for transportation to and from EIU. Please encourage your citizens to carpool and consider giving them a gas card in the amount you would have spent for bus fare.

Please reach out to your schools **NOW**. This allows you to get girls before their summer plans fill up. Once you have selected delegates and are filling out the application, it is very important to fill out the entire application. This includes the middle section with the Unit and District information. If an application comes in without that information, it slows down the process and makes it difficult to assign cities.

The planning for the 83nd session of ALA Illini Girls State is underway. We look forward to being on the beautiful campus of Eastern Illinois University and meeting all the amazing future leaders from your communities! Please let the ALA IGS Committee know if you are in need of anything as you select your delegates.
