Temporary Financial Assistance (TFA)

The American Legion's Temporary Financial Assistance (TFA) program continues to provide for the basic needs of minor children of eligible Legionnaires and military service members through cash grants. As of December 17th, the TFA program has assisted 69 minor children of 23 veterans throughout the United States maintain shelter, utilities, food, and clothing with over \$33,783 in cash grants during the calendar year of 2024. TFA grants are made possible by the support and financial generosity of Legion Family contributions and the American Legion Veterans and Children Foundation.

Each proposed revision must be submitted in triplicate. Each must also be sponsored by a Unit or signed by two members in good standing in the American Legion Auxiliary, Department of Illinois.

Warm wishes for a Happy 2025! This year the ALA IGS Committee is, "Providing the building blocks and tools to our future voters and leaders for a bright civic and political future."

The 84th session of ALA IGS Illini Girls State will be held on the campus of Eastern Illinois University in Charleston from Sunday June 15th to Saturday June 21st, 2025. During the week, the citizens will learn about the voting process, campaigning, elections, flag etiquette, patriotism and more. The committee has voted to keep the fee at \$300 for 2025. The fall packet included the citizen application, program brochure and other pertinent information. The application is also available online. We have a new and updated website for you to utilize and share with citizens, sponsors, and members. https://alaigs.org/

Recruiting and promoting this life-changing program is vital. We are asking all units to send at least one citizen to the 84th session. We also welcome donations to be sent to the Department Office for the program if the unit is unable to find or send a citizen. The ALA IGS committee works to match interested citizens with sponsorships, we do not want to turn any young lady away. Again, this year the committee will be doing a unit raffle, awarding two units a registration refund when the registration fee and completed application is in to the Department office by April 1, 2025 (first deadline) and May 1, 2025 (second deadline). We appreciate early applications to help the committee to better prepare for the session with knowledge of citizen numbers.

Now is the time to reach out to your schools and home schoolers or home school groups. We want to be the first program on these young ladies minds as they are making their summer plans. Once you have your citizen, please make sure the application is fully completed, all sections. This information is used to process the application and assign them their city at the program.

Remember we no longer offer transportation to or from the program. Options for transportation include carpooling or Units offering a gas card. On the application this year we have a line asking if they would like to share their information for carpooling. Although we discourage citizens from driving themselves, permission can be given by the Director.

In January, to increase awareness of our program, the ALA IGS committee will be sending out an email to all the schools in Illinois. However, we still need and want all Auxiliary members to reach out to their schools. But as a committee, we are also working to get the word out to help increase our attendance. To cover the cost of the program, we need a minimum of 300 citizens.

I will also be in communication with the Unit, District, and Division leadership and chairpersons to see how I can be of assistance in promoting and recruiting for the program. I know that working together we can see our numbers increase.

In January/February, be on the lookout for our ALA IGS Wishlist on Facebook and Instagram.

The planning of the ALA IGS 84th session began at the beginning of August and continues to be a work in progress. We are looking forward to meeting our future leaders and giving them an awesome ALA IGS lifechanging experience. Please know the ALA IGS committee is always here to help you, just ask.

FOR JUNIORS/SALS INTERESTED IN HOLDING AN OFFICE OR APPOINTMENT

THE FOLLOWING RULES ARE TO BE CONSIDERED WHEN SUBMITTING A NAME FOR THE VAROIUS POSITIONS.

A girl elected as Honorary Department Junior President MUST be of Junior Membership eligibility (under age 18) at the time she presides at her Conference. Candidates for President must be a Junior member. All other offices can be any participant.

The Honorary Junior President and other officers will represent the juniors at the National level according to the program arranged by National Officers.

A \$1,000 scholarship called Burns "Reel Stars" will be awarded to the Honorary Junior Department President. She must have presided over the Junior Conference prior to acceptance. It will be awarded at Department Convention. It will be given to the recipient following confirmation of enrollment in college. This scholarship is made available to the Honorary Junior Department President by Past Department President Wanita Burns.

For speaking appointments, please choose a Junior who is able to read and speak distinctly and with volume.
